



Enjoy ... but without antibiotics in feed!

Please consider:

Unfortunately antibiotics in feed are still permitted.

They help to improve the daily weight increases. Even if the advertisement promises "antibiotic-free fattening", this statement usually only refers to the final mast (e.g. with pigs starting from 40 kg live weight), not however to the pre-mast (25 to 40 kg)!

Antibiotics continue to be used prophylactically against diseases threatened due to the hostile environment which confines the animals, usually the lack of straw bedding, dim lighting and the stench of excrement and urine (liquid manure) to which they are constantly exposed.

Antibiotics in feed are jointly responsible for the emergence of antibiotic-resistant strains of bacteria.

In ecological animal husbandry antibiotics in feed are not permissible.
